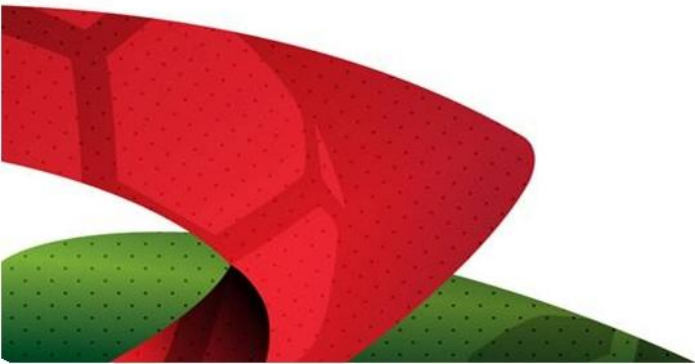
ICCE: The Mission

- **Guided by the needs of members, federations, nations and key partners.**

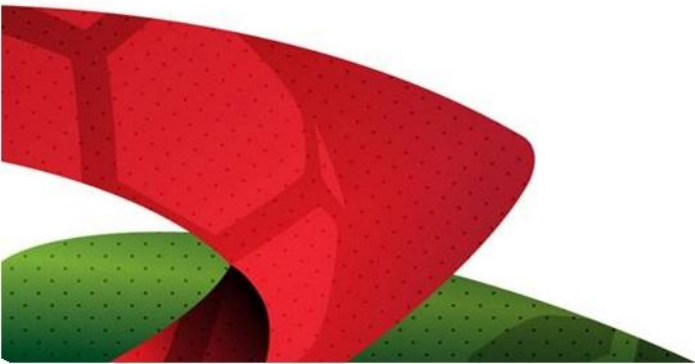

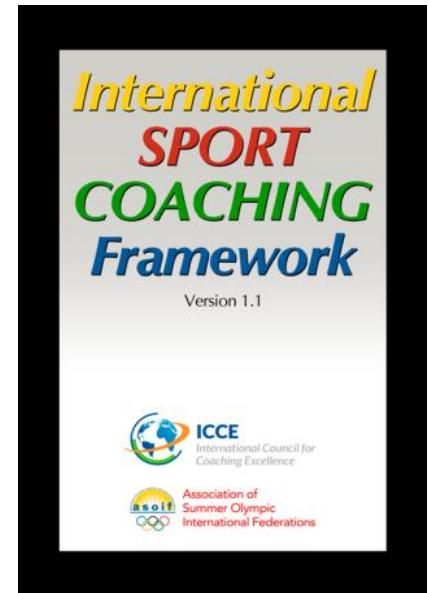

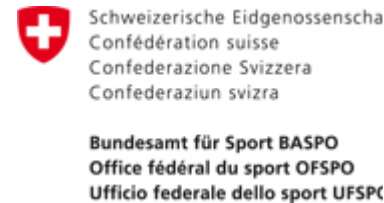


The International Sport Coaching Framework (ISCF)

- v 1.1 published during the ICCE Global Coaches House during London 2012 Games – emerging consensus
- Joint effort between ICCE and ASOIF
- An internationally recognised reference point for the development of coaching and coaches world-wide
- v 1.2 will published in Sept 2013 and reviewed every 4 years

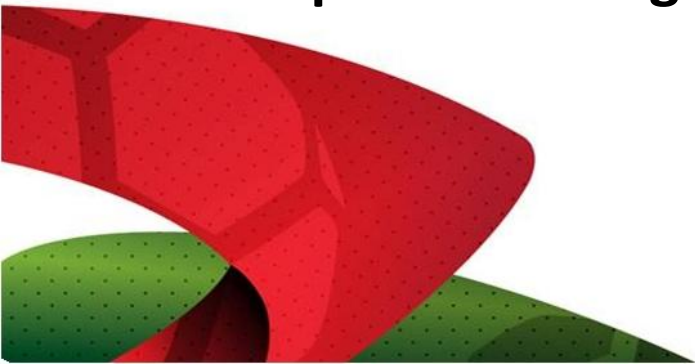
